Heritage Interior Design

Top-up your Foundation Degree to a full BA (Hons) and further develop your skills in interior design with a specialism in heritage design.

This course is specifically designed to continue your studies after completing the Foundation Degree in Heritage Interior Design, and offers the opportunity to gain a BA Honours degree.

Course Details

The course comprises 3 Modules. The first 2 Modules are worth 30 credits with the Final Project worth 60 credits.

Level 6

Equivalent to Year 3 of a full-time university degree
Modules;
1 - Heritage Conversions
2 - Research Project
3 - Final Project

Study

Part-time, via online distance learning through our Virtual Learning Studio (VLS).

Most students will take approximately 12-18 months to complete this course via flexible part-time distance learning. Some students take longer and some complete more quickly.

Entry Requirements

One of the following:

- A Foundation Degree in Heritage Interior Design or similar
- HND in Interior Design or similar (additional modules may be necessary).
- Portfolio of extensive interior design experience

What next?

You may choose to progress to a Masters Degree or PhD or access a host of graduate training programmes.

You can become a freelance designer; start your own practice or work as a qualified interior designer within an interior design or architectural practice.

Graduates with a BA (Hons) Heritage Interior Design will be sought after by owners of listed properties requiring advice and large organisations such as the National Trust or Historic Houses Association who have an increasingly challenging role maintaining a broad range of heritage properties.
