

Foundation Degree (FdA) in Heritage Interior Design

Develop your knowledge and understanding of the specific skills needed to work within the heritage sector at a residential level or on a major heritage project.

Course Details

The course comprises 8 Modules. Each Module is worth 30 credits making a total of 240 credits.

Level 4

Equivalent to Year 1 of a full-time university degree
Modules;

- 1 - **Research & Contextualisation**
- 2 - **Space Planning**
- 3 - **Design in Historical Context**
- 4 - **Traditional Design Techniques**

Level 5

Equivalent to Year 2 of a full-time university degree
Modules;

- 5 - **Design for Listed Buildings**
- 6 - **Wall, Floor & Window Treatments for Heritage Buildings**
- 7 - **Professional Practice**
- 8 - **Final Project**

Study

Part-time, online distance learning through our Virtual Learning Studio (VLS).

Most students will take approximately 2-3 years to complete this course via flexible part-time distance learning. Some students take longer and some complete more quickly.

Entry Requirements

One of the following:

- NOCN National Design Academy Level 3 Diploma
- A-Level in Art or an Art & Design based subject
- Art & Design foundation year or similar
- NVQ, BTEC, City & Guilds Level 3 in Interior Design or similar
- Portfolio of interior design experience

What next?

You are guaranteed a place on a BA (Hons) top-up; Heritage Interior Design, Interior Design or Design for Outdoor Living. Entry to the BA (Hons) Retail Design course will require the study of three further specialist FdA modules.

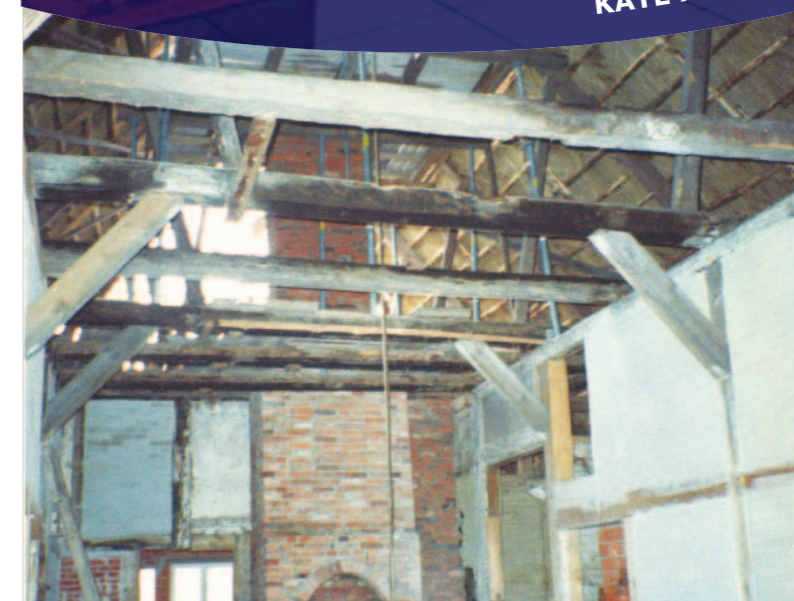
Alternatively, you can become a freelance designer; start your own practice or work as a qualified interior designer within a specialist practice or heritage organisation.
