

Foundation Degree (FdA) in Interior Design

Course Details

The course comprises 8 Modules. Each Module is worth 30 credits making a total of 240 credits.

Level 4

Equivalent to Year 1 of a full-time university degree
Modules;

- 1 - Research & Contextualisation
- 2 - Space Planning
- 3 - Design in Historical Context
- 4 - Creative Lighting & Technology

Level 5

Equivalent to Year 2 of a full-time university degree
Modules;

- 5 - Sustainable Design & Technology
- 6 - Homestaging & Show Home Design
- 7 - Professional Practice
- 8 - Furniture & Furnishings

Study

Part-time, via online distance learning through our Virtual Learning Studio (VLS).

Most students will take approximately 2-3 years to complete this course via flexible part-time distance learning. Some students take longer and some complete more quickly.

Entry Requirements

One of the following:

- NOCN National Design Academy Level 3 Diploma
- A-Level in Art or an Art & Design based subject
- Art & Design foundation year or similar
- NVQ, BTEC, City & Guilds Level 3 in Interior Design or similar
- Portfolio of interior design experience

What next?

You are guaranteed a place on a BA (Hons) top-up; Interior Design or Design for Outdoor Living. Entry to the BA (Hons) Heritage Interior Design or Retail Design courses will require the study of three further specialist FdA modules.

Alternatively, you can become a freelance designer; start your own practice or work within an interior design or architectural practice.
