Design for Outdoor Living

This course is specifically designed to continue your studies after completing a Foundation Degree, and offers the opportunity to gain a BA Honours degree.

Course Details

The course comprises 3 Modules. The first 2 Modules are worth 30 credits with the Final Project worth 60 credits.

Level 6

Equivalent to Year 3 of a full-time university degree

Modules;

- 1 - Design Technology & Materials for Outdoor Living
- 2 - Plants & Planting for Outdoor Living
- 3 - Final Project

Study

Part-time, online distance learning through our Virtual Learning Studio (VLS).

Most students will take approximately 12-18 months to complete this course via flexible part-time distance learning. Some students take longer and some complete more quickly.

Entry Requirements

One of the following:

- A Foundation Degree in Interior Design or similar
- HND in Interior Design or similar
- Portfolio of extensive interior design experience

You may choose to progress to a Masters Degree or PhD or access a host of graduate training programmes.

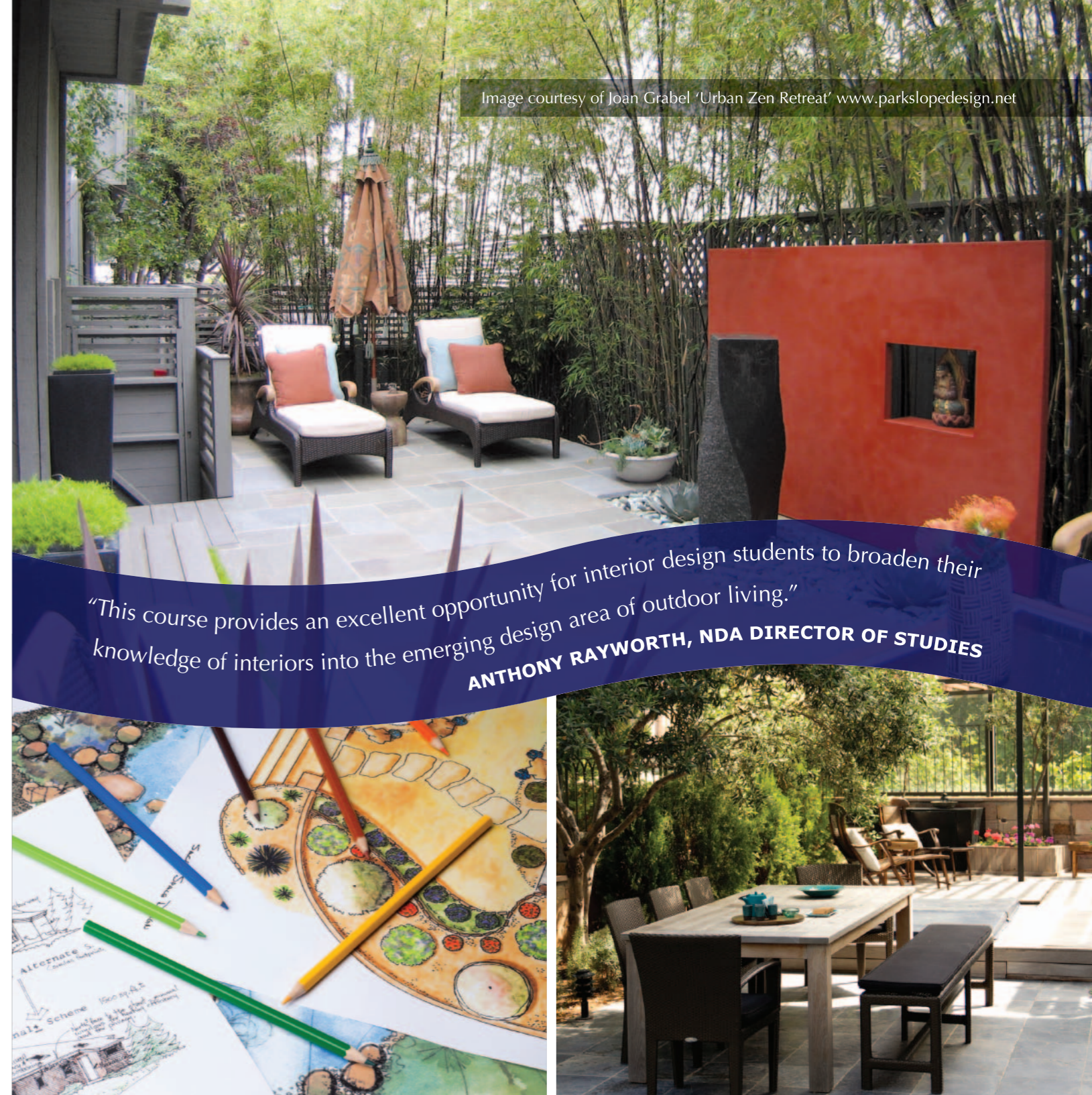
